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OVD 919 SOUTH AFRICA

Nestled below Lion's Head, this family home capitalises on spectacular views. The architecture draws strength from the concrete finish used to create monumental forms which contrast to the copper roof.



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DOUBLE BAY AUSTRALIA

Overlooking a sheltered bay within Sydney's world famous natural harbour, this family home creates private, sheltered spaces for family living.



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INVERMARK SOUTH AFRICA

Invermark overlooks the city and harbour of Cape Town. Originally designed by architect Gilbert Colyn in 1969, inspired by Phillip Johnson's 1949 Glass House and Mies van der Rohe's 1951 Farnsworth House.



COVE 3 SOUTH AFRICA

Sited on a cliff-top estate in Pezula, Knysna, this home integrates with the topography and natural colour of the fynbos flora, maintaining a seamless connection with landscape and ocean.

KLOOF 145 SOUTH AFRICA

Situated on a very steep site with spectacular ocean and mountain views, the open plan design maximises connections with the surrounding landscape. Bold landscape elements are used to break the scale of the house and integrate to the mountain.



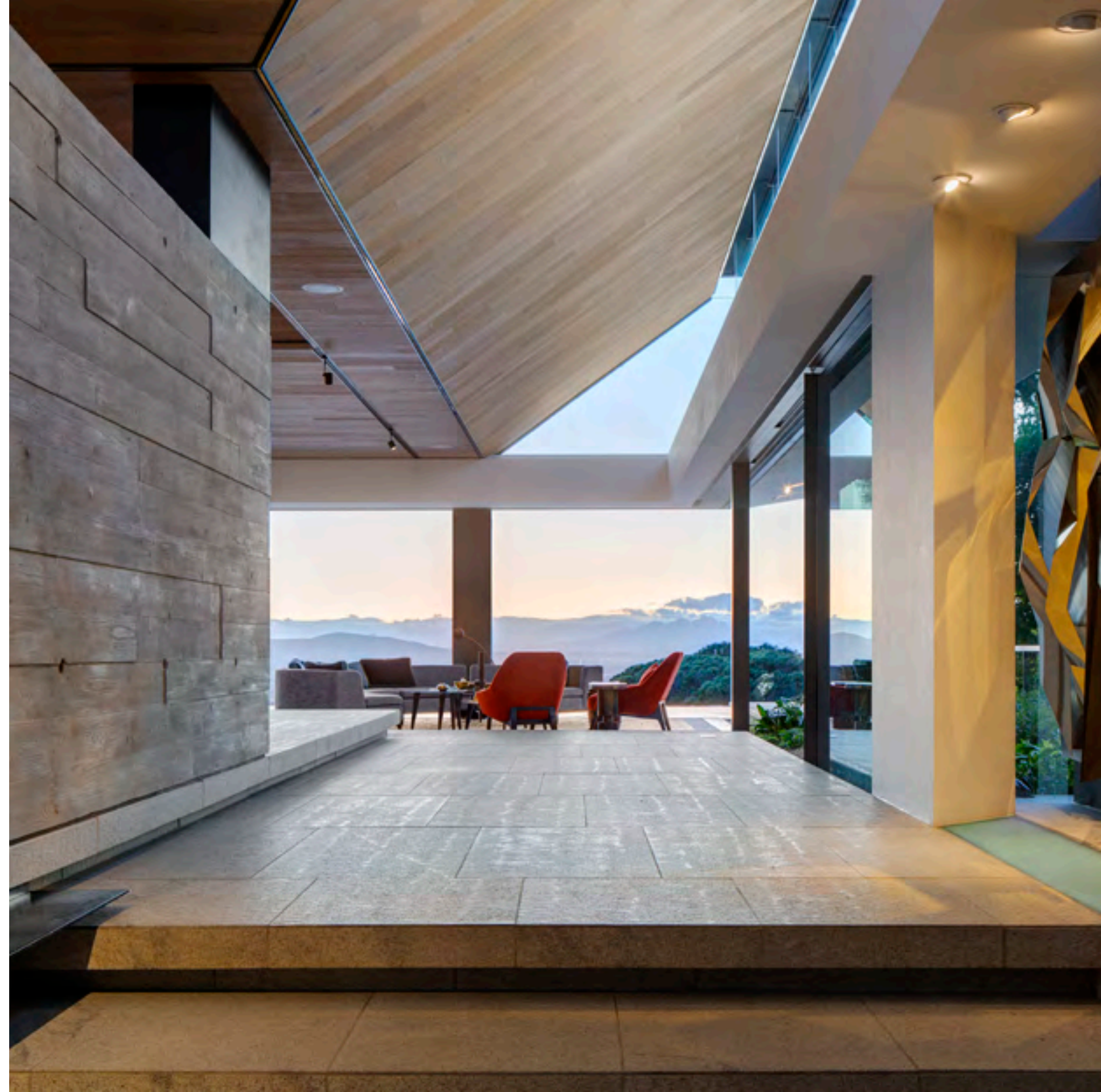
LE PINE FRANCE

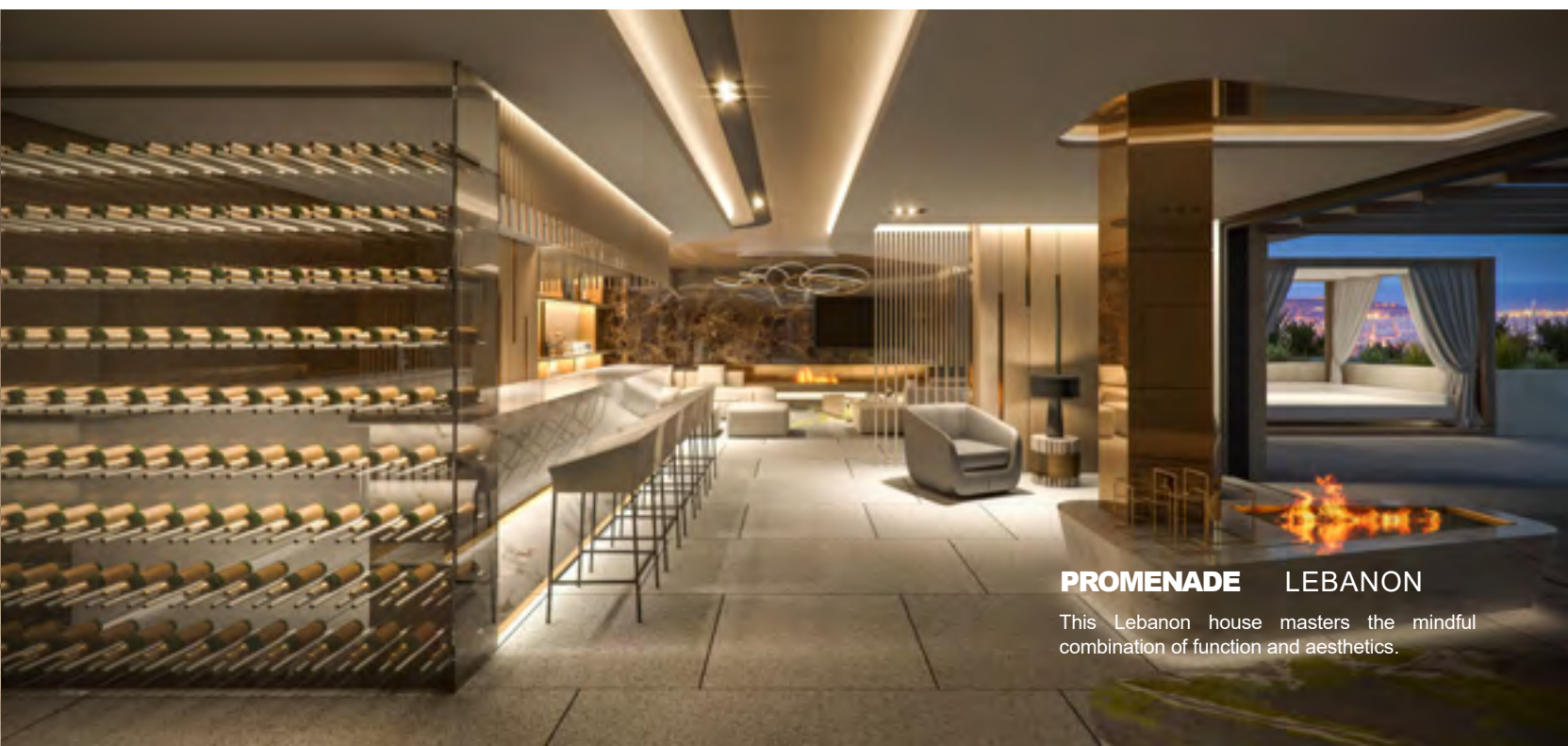
BOMA SOUTH AFRICA

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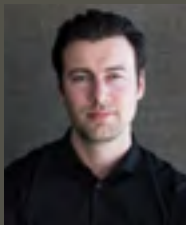
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
